

All Hallow's Eve Wall Quitt featuring Penny Rose By Amanda Niederhauser of Jedi Craft Girl

Neutral background


4 neutral fabrics, cut 5"squares for a total of 49 squares. Follow the placement guide below and continue with the pattern. Sew the squares together in rows and then the rows together using ¼" seams. Press all seams.


Gray/Black boarder From the gray/black prints cut (48) 3" x 6" rectangles cut (8) 1 1/2" x 6" rectangles cut (4) 6" squares

Fabric Requirements 1/4 yard cuts (4) neutral fabrics 1/4 yard cuts 10-12 gray/black prints 1 yard black fabric for tree 34 yard black ticking for binding 1 ½ yard backing 2 yard Heat n Bond Lite

Sew (12) 3" x 6" rectangles together. Add a 1 1/4" x 6" rectangle to each end. Sew a 6" square to each end.



Sew 2 of these. Then sew 2 more strip sets together omitting the 6" squares.



Press strips. Before attaching border strips, applique the tree, moon, and cat first to reduce bulk.

Applique

All applique uses Heat n Bond Lite and then is straight stitched on. Make sure all applique is traced in reverse of the image pictured. For the tree, enlarge the tree until you get it the desired size. Iron the heat n bond lite to the wrong side of the black fabric, about a 30" square. Trace the tree onto the heat n bond. Cut out the tree and peel off the backing paper.

Trace the cat onto a separate piece of Heat n Bond Lite. For the moon, trace a regular pie plate onto the heat n bond lite. Iron the cat and moon to the wrong side of the desired fabric. Cut out, peel off backing paper.

Position the tree, moon, and cat as pictured below. Heat set in place and sew around each piece using matching thread.



Finishing, sew the two shorter boarders to the sides. Press seams. Sew the two longer boarders to the top and bottom. Press. Quilt, Bind.
